About the Role

The Manor Park Oasis is a meanwhile use community space located on a previously vacant site on High Street North managed by the Renewal Programme. We are running a range of activities in the space such as community gardening, creative workshops and art classes, games, chess or table tennis and we are looking for volunteers to support us activating the site through running activities and engaging local residents of all ages.

You will volunteer as part of a small team, supported by our project lead, to support us running activities or lead your own activities in the space. We are in particular looking for people interested in running arts & crafts sessions, our chess club, and weekly games drop-ins. However, we strongly encourage each volunteer to bring their own ideas, personality and skills to the table. We are open to new ideas for activities you would like to run, so get in touch if you have a particular skill you would like to share with people or a session you would like to facilitate!

Volunteer tasks include:

- Setting up and packing away activities
- Running activities with people
- Engage with local communities, encouraging them to join activities and get involved
- Volunteering for one-off events and celebrations taking place in the space
- Providing visitors with information about the space and our activities
- Supporting the team with keeping the space clean, tidy, and safe
